






IN SOUTH CAROLINA, 39% OF CHILDREN ARE READY FOR SCHOOL; HORRY COUNTY IS BELOW THE STATE AVERAGE AT 27%.



## IN HORRY COUNTY ONLY 1 SCHOOL HAD OVER 50% OF STUDENTS DEMONSTRATING READINESS.
